

ORDINANCE NO. 1452

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8 OF THE JENKS CITY CODE "FIRE PREVENTION", ARTICLE 3, SECTION 8-3-1 "DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS" TO ELIMINATE JULY 5<sup>TH</sup> AS A DATE ON WHICH THE DISCHARGE OF CONSUMER FIREWORKS IS PERMITTED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JENKS:

*Section I. Chapter 8, section 8-3-1(D)(4) shall be amended to read as follows:*

"Discharge occurs on July 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4th between the hours of noon and 11 p.m."

*Section II. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.*


*Section III. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any part thereof.*

Since the immediate operation of the provisions of the Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of public health, welfare and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council.

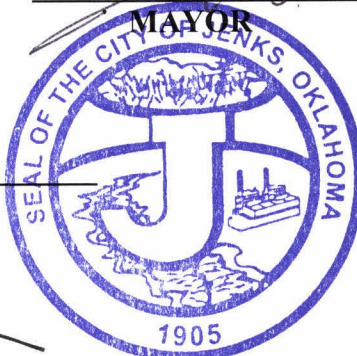
